- Margot Wendice-** late 30's to mid 40's, wife of Tony, recently had an affair, British
- Max Halliday-** late 30's to mid 40's, friend and former lover of Margot, American
- Tony Wendice-** late 30's to mid 40's, husband of Margot, former tennis pro, plots to have his wife killed.
- Captain Lesgate-** 40- early 50's, former college acquaintance of Tony's, a crook. British
- Inspector Hubbard-** 40- 65 years old, a shrewd detective from Scotland Yard.

All the roles are choice and well written. The ages listed are merely suggestions to what the characters ages should be, but please don't let that stop you from auditioning. Paddy is planning on being flexible with that. Line loads vary from medium to heavy, and British accents are expected.
